

Formal Request for Oregon Community Solar Pre-Application Report

Pursuant to Public Utility Commission of Oregon Order 19-392, a potential Community Solar Project Manager may provide identifying information in order for Idaho Power to complete a Pre-Application Report. The Community Solar Project Manager must also provide a non-refundable fee of \$300 to Idaho Power to complete the formal request, unless they have certified with the Community Solar Program Administrator as a non-profit or governmental based program manager. A certified non-profit or community-based project manager must provide the Program Administrator documentation demonstrating the certification, and then may receive up to five reports at no cost.
