Participant Spotlight: JEMfriends

Rooted in Hope, Growing in Purpose

Across the United States, more than 500,000 children live in foster care, and each year about 16,000 age out without a family or stable support system. Idaho is no exception.

With more than 1,500 children in the state's foster system, many exit without permanent homes, and only 47% have graduated from high school or earned a GED by age 19. These barriers place youth at greater risk of homelessness, incarceration, and instability.

JEMfriends is working to change that story. JEMfriends ensures that young people aging out of foster care never have to navigate adulthood alone. Through safe housing, transportation support, mentoring, and the four-phase Independent Living Program, JEMfriends helps Idaho youth build stability, confidence, and essential life skills.

As one youth shared:

"At JEMfriends, they taught me how to advocate for myself, access resources, and take the steps toward independence."

For JEMfriends, caring for youth also means caring for the future they will inherit. Their participation in the *Clean Energy Your Way—Flexible Option* (CEYW) reflects a commitment to responsible stewardship and long-term stability.

By pairing their electricity with renewable energy credits (REC), JEMfriends demonstrates that small, intentional choices can create meaningful change. They hope their involvement inspires other nonprofits and households to make environmentally responsible decisions that strengthen both communities and futures.

Stay Cool and Earn with A/C Cool Credit

Looking for an easy way to earn an incentive on your summer power bills while supporting a more reliable grid? Idaho Power's A/C Cool Credit program rewards residential customers who help reduce electricity use during periods of high demand.

Now enrolling for 2026, the program offers two simple ways to participate:

- With A/C cycling, Idaho Power installs a small device on your central air conditioning unit. On a few select

weekday afternoons throughout the summer, the unit cycles on and off to reduce strain on the system without sacrificing comfort.

- New in 2026, customers now have the option to enroll using a smart thermostat. During high-demand periods, your thermostat automatically makes minor temperature adjustments to shift some energy use away from peak hours.

How does Clean Energy Your Way – Flexible Option compare to the standard energy mix?

Idaho Power's 2025 mix of resources supplying Idaho Power customers included: Hydroelectric (34.2%), Coal (9.9%), Natural Gas (22.9%), and Other (33.0%).

How is Clean Energy Your Way – Flexible Option sold?

It is sold in blocks of 100 kWh or matches 100% of your energy (kWh) use.

As of 2025, the average home in Idaho Power's service area uses 900 kWh per month. For the average home, the 100% Option would add \$9.00 (on average) to the monthly bill to pair all its energy with RECs. As an example of the Block Option, a purchase of 5 Blocks of RECs covers over half of the average home's energy use for an extra \$5.00 each month.

Follow the Feathers: Birdwatching with Idaho Power



Idaho Power manages extensive wildlife habitats that offer excellent birdwatching opportunities, supported by detailed bird checklists for areas including Hells Canyon, C.J. Strike, and the Hagerman Valley. These checklists highlight seasonal species and habitat types based on avian surveys, guides, and bird-count data, helping both new and experienced birders identify birds they're likely to see. The company's stewardship efforts, like enhancing riparian areas, improving access, and supporting diverse bird populations, make these lands ideal for wildlife viewing. Together, Idaho's landscapes and Idaho Power's resources create a rich, accessible birdwatching experience. Three segments of the Idaho Birding Trail are located on our C.J. Strike Habitat Management area, and you'll find another at Shoshone Falls Park.
