## HEATING AND COOLING EFFICIENCY PROGRAM HYBRID HEAT PUMP WATER HEATER SPECIFICATION



Residential customers can receive the Idaho Power incentive for having a qualified heat pump water heater installed into their existing or new construction home. The incentive is available to residential customers throughout the Idaho Power service area. The homeowner / property owner will process and submit the necessary incentive forms. Homes receiving this incentive may not receive incentives for the same equipment under another Idaho Power incentive program. One incentive per home is available. Homeowners, property owners, builders are responsible for complying with all applicable codes and regulations.

### **PROGRAM REQUIREMENTS**

#### **General**

- The incentive is available to homeowners, property owners, builders.
- The heat pump water heater can be self-installed or professionally installed.
- If existing home, homeowner, property owner, builder must be replacing an existing electric storage water heater.
- Home must be single-family site built, manufactured, duplex, triplex, or fourplex.
- Home can be a primary residence, vacation home, or rental.
- No minimum length of residency.
- If new construction home natural gas cannot be available.

#### **Equipment**

- The heat pump water heater must be new.
- The tank size must be equal to or less than 55 gallons and a minimum of Tier 2.
- The heat pump water heater must be listed on the Qualified Products List shown on the incentive website.
- If a combustion appliance is present in the home or attached garage, homeowner, property owner, builder must ensure an approved working carbon monoxide (CO) detector is in the home.
