HEATING AND COOLING EFFICIENCY PROGRAM **DUCTLESS HEAT PUMP SPECIFICATION**



Customers can receive the Idaho Power incentive for having a qualified ductless heat pump installed in a qualified home. Incentive is available to customers throughout Idaho Power service area. The Participating Contractor will install equipment, and process all incentive forms. Homes receiving this ductless heat pump incentive may not receive incentives for the same equipment under another Idaho Power incentive program. One incentive per home is available regardless of the number of systems installed in the home.

REQUIREMENTS

General

- Home must have hard wired existing electric baseboards, electric ceiling cable, or electric wall units in the main living area
- Qualified scenarios:
 - Home can be primary residence, vacation home or rental
 - Home can be single-family site built, manufactured, duplex, triplex or fourplex.
 - No minimum length of residency
 - Supplemental heat is allowed:
 - Stove or fireplace with pellet, wood, propane, natural gas, oil, or kerosene fuel.
 - Natural gas usage for dryer, water heater and stovetop acceptable
- Scenarios not qualified:
 - Homes with electric portable plug-in space heaters for primary heat source
 - Homes with forced air systems:
 - Natural gas, propane or oil
 - Heat pumps
 - Electric resistance
 - Fossil fuel hydronic heat
 - Natural gas space heaters in main living area
 - New construction

Equipment

- Minimum one indoor unit installed in the primary living space
- Multi-zone systems are allowed
- · Existing heat remains in place as back up
- Outdoor unit must be have inverter driven compressor, variable speed fan in outdoor unit, and variable/multiple speed indoor blower
- Rigid line set covers must be installed over line sets on the home exterior
- Ductless heat pumps with attached ducts are not allowed
- •Must be installed by an authorized Participating Contractor
