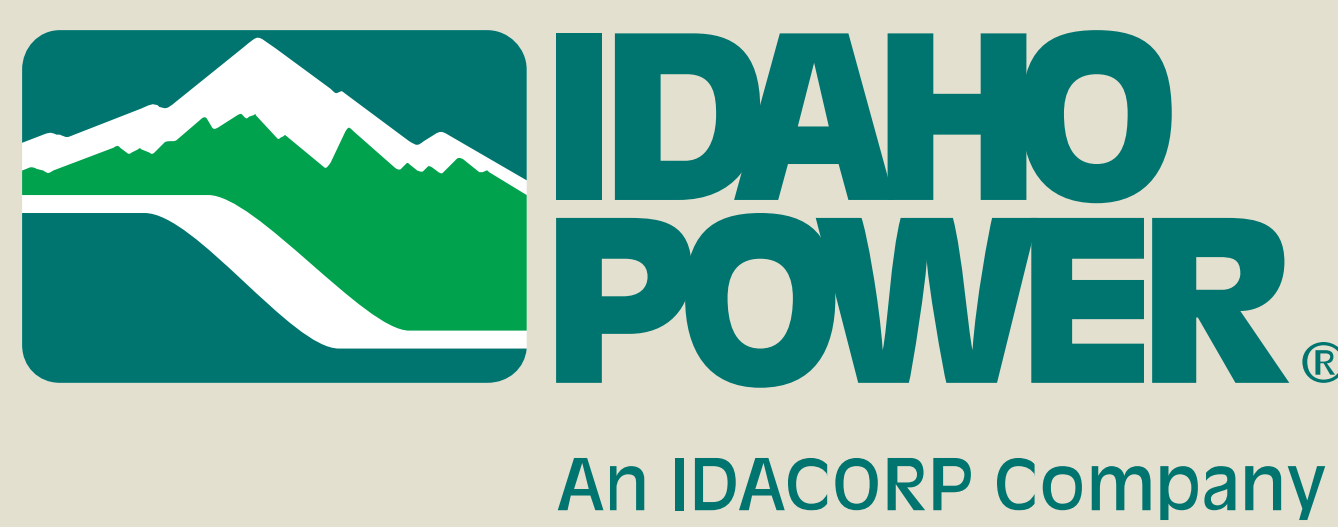


# C. J. Strike Hydroelectric Project
